LUCINDA AND SANDY ROSEN

Yad Ezra's leadership is thrilled to pay tribute to Lucinda and Sandy Rosen, who have been actively involved in our organization for many years. When their kids were becoming Bat and Bar mitzvah, Lucinda and Sandy started looking for a meaningful experience that would resonate with the whole family. They began volunteering at **Yad Ezra**, escorting clients as they chose their groceries and helping out with other tasks in the warehouse. In 2017, Sandy joined **Yad Ezra's** board of directors and he continues to serve on a variety of committees.

In 2018, **Yad Ezra's** leadership decided to assist Rabbi Michael Schudrich, the Chief Rabbi of Poland, establish a kosher food pantry in Warsaw for low income Jewish families and Righteous Gentiles. In 2019, Lucinda and Sandy participated in **Yad Ezra's** mission trip to Poland to meet with the rabbi and other leaders in the Krakow and Warsaw Jewish community, pack and deliver groceries and visit with some of the individuals receiving food assistance from the newly established pantry. In addition, Rosen family members continue to volunteer in the warehouse: they helped with Passover preparations this year for **Yad Ezra's** curb side delivery for 1,200 families and they have been making regular weekly grocery deliveries to client families since the Covid crisis began.

Professionally, Lucinda is a CPA but she chose to stop practicing once she and Sandy had children. Sandy is the former president/CEO of GLR Companies, Metal, Paper, Plastic and Electronics Recycling. Sandy serves on the executive committee of Adat Shalom Synagogue and the board of Aish HaTorah. He is a former president of the Paper Stock Industries Chapter of the Institute of Scrap Recycling Industries.

Lucinda and Sandy are the proud parents of Carly Rosen, age 29, IDF veteran and third year DPT Student at U of M Flint; Ryan Rosen, DO, age 28, a first year surgery resident at DMC; and Sydney Rosen, age 24, a 4th year DVM student at Colorado State University.

When asked why **Yad Ezra's** mission resonates with them, Sandy's response was "Because hunger impacts so many and it's relatively easy to combat things like hunger, homelessness, etc. It's satisfying to directly see the results of our efforts. We have been unbelievably blessed in so many ways; it would be criminal not to share our blessings with others. We are part of a community, and if the shoe was on the other foot, we would certainly hope that others would help us."
